TO THE MEMBERS OF SHASHANK FINVEST PVT. LTD.,

Report on the Standalone Financial Statements

#### Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Standalone financial statements of SHASHANK FINVEST PVT. LTD. ("the Company") which comprises the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2022, the Statement of Profit and Loss for the year& Cash Flow Statement then ended, and notes to the Standalone financial statements, including a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid Standalone financial statements give the information required by the Act in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at March 31, 2022, and profit for the year ended on that date.

#### Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements section of our report. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

#### Key Audit Matters

Key audit Matters are those matters that, in our professional judgment, were of most significance in our audit of the Standalone financial statements of the current period. These matters were addressed in the context of our audit of the Standalone financial statements as a whole, and in forming our opinion thereon, and we do not provide a separate opinion on these matters.

Reporting of key audit matters as per SA 701, Key Audit Matters are not applicable to the Company as it is an unlisted company.

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate implementation and maintenance of accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Standalone financial statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Standalone financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so. The Boards of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the company's financial reporting process.

### Auditor's Responsibility for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Standalone financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. #### NOTE 1: SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Accounting Convention

The accounts are prepared on historical cost convention under the going concern concept.

#### Revenue Recognition

Items of Income and Expenditure are recognized on accrual basis except rates & taxes and filing fees, which are accounted for on cash basis.

#### Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets

A provision is held in respect of an obligation if and only if

- a) the company has a present obligation as a result of a past event;
- b) it is probable that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the obligation, and
- c) reliable estimate can be made of the amount of obligation.

#### Investment

Investments are long term in nature and valued and stated at Cost.

#### Taxation

Provision for current taxation is ascertained on the basis of assessable profits as computed in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

Deferred tax is recognised, subject to the consideration of prudence, on timing differences, being the difference between taxable incomes and accounting income that originate in one period and are capable of reversal in one or more subsequent periods.

Earnings per Share

Basic & Diluted Earnings per Share are calculated by dividing the net profit or loss for the period attributable to equity shareholders.
